WHY: The 2009 Pandemic Flu 2009 H1N1 Injectable vaccine is being offered to children enrolled in the Firebaugh-Las Deltas Unified School District. A parent must be present in order to provide authorized consent. There is no cost for the vaccine.

The Centers for Disease Control has identified children ages 6 months to 24 years as one of the priority groups needing the H1N1 vaccine to protect them from the illness.
